He holds an M.S. (Ingenieur) degree in Applied Physics from the Delft University of Technology, Delft, the Netherlands (1973), and an M.S. degree in Environmental Management from the University of Wisconsin, Madison, Wisconsin (1975).

Mr. TenWolde is an active member of ASHRAE. He chaired the revision of the 1997 and 2001 ASHRAE Handbook of Fundamentals chapters on moisture control in buildings, and is chairman of ASHRAE Standard 160P, Design Criteria for Moisture Control in Buildings. He has conducted research on moisture control in buildings since 1980, and has authored or co-authored more than 50 articles and reports on that subject.
